MEDICO-LEGAL EXPERIENCE: I have provided expert opinion since 1997, and currently prepare about 60 reports per year. Apart from general gynaecology, my particular interest is in the area of operative complications related to benign gynaecological surgery. I have appeared in Court or at GMC hearings on nine occasions. The ratio of opinion I have given on behalf of claimants to defendant is now about 1:1. All reports are provided electronically with copies of relevant references. The average turn-around time for reports in 2024 was 21 days once all documentation was available.	
SPECIAL SKILLS: I have more than 43 years experience in Obstetrics and Gynaecology, including 31 years as a Consultant. My main area of expertise is in the area of consent for surgery, operative complications, minimal access surgery (laparoscopy and hysteroscopy), hysterectomy and myomectomy, including bowel, ureter, bladder and vascular injury. I have been a member of a number of Working Groups, Advisory Panels and Sub-Committees advising the Royal College of Obstetricians and Gynaecologists on aspects of minimal access and endoscopic surgery. Between 1989 and 2011, I was involved in the organisation of postgraduate training courses on endoscopic and vaginal surgery. I have more than 250 publications in peer reviewed scientific journals and books, a large proportion on endoscopic surgery and hysterectomy. I have written the chapter on "Hysteroscopy and Laparoscopy" published in the two editions of a standard postgraduate UK textbook, Dewhurst's Textbook of Obstetrics and Gynaecology. I have made over 420 presentations and national and international scientific meetings.
